Step 2 Procedure for Virtus Classification Application

Virtus Classification required

Does the swimmer meet the required eligibility criteria of:


- 1. An full scale IQ score of 75 or below
- 2. Evidence of significant limitations in adaptive behaviour
- 3. Evidence of age of onset before the age of 18

Seek further advice regarding application and documentation required

Gather supporting documentation and evidence

- a) Photo with name on reverse
- b) Photograph page of current passport
- c) IQ test & report Fully completed & signed and in correct format
- d) Copy of IQ Summary sheet (raw scores).
- e) Adaptive behaviour test & report Fully completed & signed and in correct format.
- f) Copy of Adaptive behaviour Summary sheet (raw scores).
- g) Evidence of Age of onset both documentary if available, but always with summary statement in psychologist reports.
