- 1. Go to <u>swimmingresults.org</u> and select the entry page that you require. Entries open **Monday 27th January 2025.**
- 2. Enter your membership number or surname in the box.
- 3. Providing you have a recent photograph in your <u>biog</u>, a list with the events you have qualified in will appear ticked.
- 4. Untick any events which you do not wish to enter.
- 5. Payment is via debit or credit card; please follow the PayPal payment instructions. You do not need a PayPal account to do this. Your entry will not be complete until you receive a confirmation of payment email from Paypal.

ENTRY CLOSING DATE

All processed entries must be made via the online entry system by **no later than 17.00 on Tuesday 18th March.**

Please note that for the 2025 Championships, no entries beyond the closing date will be accepted.

SPORT NATIONALITY

<u>Championship Condition 1e makes reference to Sport Nationality – the</u> <u>following is an abridged explanation of what this means</u>

In order to be eligible to compete at an International Competition an athlete shall have a 'Sport Nationality' to represent a World Aquatics Member in this case Great Britain (GBR) To satisfy this requirement he/she shall be affiliated to GBR and is a citizen of the Country that the Athlete represents by virtue of:

a) being a citizen of the Country by birth; or

b) being a citizen of the Country through naturalization and having uninterrupted residence in the Country for at least three years prior to his/her first International Competition.

This requirement must be in place to progress to a Final. Any potential entrant who is not sure if they comply with this requirement must contact the Event Officer before submitting an entry.





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The full requirements in relation to 'Sport Nationality' by World Aquatics can be found **here** in World Aquatics Rules – Competition Regulation 3 (Page 8-9).

ACCREDITATION

All competitors, coaches, chaperones and support staff must have a valid accreditation to gain access to the event. Accreditation is non-transferable and must be always worn to access athlete areas and Field of Play.

If the pass is forgotten, lost or mislaid, a replacement pass will be re-issued for a fee of $\underline{$ 10.00 at the Sport Information Desk.

ATHLETES

Your accreditation will be sent to you by email in PDF format upon completion of your entry.

Please print and bring with you to the event where you can collect a pouch and lanyard from the Sport Information Desk.

The barcodes contain your membership number and will be scanned to check the details against the entry database.

COACHES/TEAM MANAGERS/CHAPERONES

All coaches and team staff must have a valid photo accreditation to gain access to the pool deck. Applications for coach/chaperone passes will be charged at £26.00 per event. A valid DBS check, safeguarding qualification and fulfilment of the minimum qualification/requirement for the specific role (stated below) you are undertaking is required.

Coaches and Team Staff accreditations will be opened no later than 17th March 2025.





Withdrawals

We are aware of previous incidents whereby athletes have had withdrawals submitted in their name which are false. Such fraudulent actions have caused distress and additional work.

As a measure to prevent this from continuing to occur the following process will be introduced.

Withdrawal of an athlete from either a heat or final of an event can only be carried out by a Team Staff member of the athlete's club who are in possession of a Coach, Team Manager or Chaperone event accreditation.

We encourage that accreditations are purchased early, once open, to ensure athletes can be withdrawn.

Once a relevant accreditation has been issued team staff will have access via a unique code to submit withdrawals.

DBS/PVG and Safeguarding

Swim England

All Swim England clubs and license applicants will have completed a DBS (CRB) application regardless of any previous check carried out through another organisation unless this has been registered with the DBS Update Service <u>www.gov.uk/dbs-update-service</u>. If you hold a disclosure that has been registered with the DBS Update Service, and you have not yet given the Swim England written consent to check the status, please submit your original disclosure certificate along with a completed consent form to <u>dbs@swimming.org</u>. Please also email <u>dbs@swimming.org</u> for a DBS Update Service Consent form.

Minimum Qualification/Requirements (specific to accredited role)

- Coaches Coaching Qualification or Assistant Coach Certificate
- Team Manager Team Manager Training Module 1 or 2 Certificate
- Chaperone Club authorisation to be acting in loco parentis on behalf of the Club





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PLEASE NOTE: It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure a DBS is in place and a pass has been purchased to attend the event. Under no circumstances will any person be allowed entry to the event without the relevant safeguarding checks in place and pass issued.

Scottish Swimming, Swim Wales and International Poolside Passes must be created and sent manually. They will be sent out prior to the event if you have the appropriate Safeguarding checks and qualifications on file.

Poolside passes will be emailed to you in PDF format to print out and bring to the event, please ensure you print these before arriving at the venue. Pouches and lanyards will be provided.

WARM UP AND SWIM DOWN

Warm up in the competition pool will begin 90 minutes prior to the start of the session and will end 15 minutes prior to the start of the session.

Swim down will be in the training pool.

TEAM LEADER MEETING

It is strongly recommended that a representative from all clubs with swimmers entered in this Meet should attend the Team Leader Meeting which will provisionally take place at **<u>18:00 on Monday 14th April</u>**. Further information will be provided within the confirmation pack.

Non-attendance could result in swimmers being disadvantaged or not able to compete due to them or their coach not being aware of any changes required for the running of the competition.

Timelines for the final's sessions will be issued at the team leader meeting.

FILMING AND PHOTOGRAPHY

FILMING AND PHOTOGRAPHY POLICY

Aquatics GB are aware of the wide range of devices including mobile telephones which have photographic and filming capabilities. This enables the capture of both static and moving images. It should be acknowledged that the majority of images taken within an Aquatics GB setting are appropriate and taken in good faith. However, images of children and adults can be misused, and sharing images widely without consent may betray a confidence or identify of a child or adult, which could present a risk of harm to that individual if common sense procedures are not followed.

Parents and carers of participants under the age of 18 who wish to take images are requested to focus on their own children as much as reasonably possible and to avoid including other children in images, particularly if those images are being shared with family and friends or through social media platforms. Whilst it is acknowledged that parents/carers wish to celebrate the achievements of their own children when taking part in aquatic events, it should be recognised and respected that other parents/carers may not wish for their child's image to be taken and shared in this way.

Aquatics GB encourage all spectators and participants at Aquatics GB events to make themselves familiar with the photography and filming arrangements for the event and be vigilant during that event.

Aquatics GB is committed to ensuring that all children who participate in Aquatics GB activities can take part in an enjoyable, safe environment and be safeguarded from harm. If you have any child safeguarding concerns at the event, please contact an Event Officer immediately to disclose your concerns.





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EVENT PHOTOGRAPHY AND FILMING
